At North Mead, we value reading. Reading is the most important skill our children learn and above all, we want our children to love reading. Through the current school closure, we want children to read for 20 minutes per day – just like they do when we are all at school together. No matter how old your child is, please get them to read to you or another family member and, read independently too. Reading is a wonderful thing to do together! Every child from Year 1 upwards has a school device for the lock down period. Below are some resources you can use to read on these devices or any devices you may have access with internet access.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Children from North Mead can read ebooks from Oxford Owls and Get Epic*. Your child may also have access to 'real' books at home or any books from school which they borrowed before lockdown. Books in Oxford Owls are very similar to those which children would borrow from school but in ebook format. Get Epic has hundreds of books which children can read and listen to. Children from North Mead can read ebooks from MyOn, Oxford Owls and Get Epic*. Your child may also have access to 'real' books at home or any books from school which they borrowed before lockdown. At home, your child can also access **Accelerated Reader** in which children take quizzes on the books they read. This allows your child's teacher to see how much your child has understand and how much time they have spent reading.

- **All** ebooks in MyOn have Accelerated Reader quizzes
- **Most** ebooks on the Oxford Owls website have Accelerated Reader quizzes
- **Some** Get Epic books have Accelerated Reader quizzes
- **Most** 'real' books have Accelerated Reader quizzes.
- Use the website www.arbookfind.co.uk to search for books which have Accelerated Reader quizzes.

Children from year 3 upwards should spend a minimum of 20 minutes reading per day – whether that's an ebook or a 'real' book. Please see instructions below for how your child can access these books.
